

## **BEHAVIOR AND DRESS CODE – REGIONAL TOURNAMENTS**

Please remember that you represent all of WNYSRA and that your behavior both on and off the field is a direct reflection on your colleagues.

**DRESS CODE FOR ALL SPECIAL EVENTS:** USSF Formal: Blue blazer, white or blue shirt, USSF tie, gray trousers for men, over-the knee skirts and stockings for women, black socks, and black shoes.

**DRESS CODE FOR TRAVEL AND ON SITE:** USSF Casual: Clean USSF polo shirt ( or any clean polo shirt), khaki trousers, black socks and black shoes. Remember to be properly dressed at all times including in dormitories, classrooms, and going out for meals. No cut-offs, tee shirts, flip-flops or trousers or shorts with holes.

**ATTEND ALL REFEREE AND DELEGATION MEETINGS.**  
Appear on time and properly dressed. There are no excuses not to attend meetings unless specifically excused by your Head of Delegation or by the Tournament Director.

At all such tournaments there may be schedule changes and the assignor may ask you to fill in with matches above or below your referee grade or ask you to do significantly fewer matches than you anticipated. Take it all in stride. Report any assaults immediately to the tournament director.
